SAFETY	IMMIGRATION
Do you feel unsafe at home and want to talk about your options?	Does your family have a safety plan if someone gets arrested by ICE?
Are you afraid someone is going to hurt you?	Have you ever had a removal or deportation order?
s someone harassing, stalking, or threatening you? Is Child Protective Services (CPS) nvolved with your family?	Are you undocumented and want to know your immigration options?
	HOUSING
DEBTS, FEES, FINES Do you have unpaid court fines?	 Did you get an eviction notice or other notice from your landlord? Is your landlord not repairing your home? Are the conditions unsafe?
Do you owe money to a hospital or doctor's office?	Is your landlord harassing you or discriminating against you?
Do you have tickets you can't pay?	Do you have an eviction record or outstanding rental debt?
Are you getting calls from a collections agency?	CUSTODY
Do you want to change your name and/or gender marker? Do you need to get your identifying documents? Do you think someone used your name or social security number without your permission?	Do you have children and need help with getting or keeping custody?
	Are you taking care of someone else's children and want to make it official? Do you need help making sure someone else can take care of your children because you can't right now? Are you under 18 and your parents disagree with where you want to live?

EDUCATION

Do you have a disability and need support in school?	Do you need help paying for your basic needs like food and medical care?
Do you need help enrolling in or getting to school?	Do you have a disability and it keeps you from being able to meet your basic needs?
Are you having trouble accessing school because of tech issues?	Did you apply for benefits but you think you were unfairly denied?
Were you unfairly suspended or expelled?	Is someone taking your benefits and/or do you want to receive your benefits directly?

Do you think you have a warrant?	Are you recently unemployed? Were you unfairly fired?
Do you want to seal your criminal record?	Does your employer owe you money?
Do you have fines from a criminal case you can't pay?	Were you harassed or discriminated against at work?
Were you denied housing or employment due to criminal history?	Do you have a disability that affects your work?
HEALTH	CAR ISSUES
Do you need access to medical or mental health care?	Was your car unfairly taken (towed, impounded, or repossessed)?
Is someone threatening to commit you to inpatient treatment?	Is your license suspended?
Are you under 18 and want to consent to your own health care confidentially?	Are you having trouble with your car that you bought recently?
